



IASA Position Statement regarding Rider Responsibility:

As the lead organization promoting excellence in the management of organized recreational snowmobiling, the International Association of Snowmobile Administrators recognizes Safe riders make snowmobiling safe. It is the position of IASA that each individual snowmobiler is responsible for their actions as they affect personal safety, access, and the overall image of the sport. Therefore the IASA believes that every snowmobile rider must:

1. **Know how to obtain appropriate training**, education, and information related to the safe operation of their vehicle.
2. **Know how to reduce the operational impact** of their vehicle on the natural environment, other recreationalists, and the community at large.
3. **Know with certainty that they have permission** to enter and use every riding opportunity they choose to access.
4. **Know the laws, obligations, and expectations** associated with the entry and use of every riding opportunity they choose to access.
5. **Know how they have contributed their fair share** to the cost of creating and maintaining every riding opportunity they choose to access.
